


LONG LIVE THE BAT







WHAT TO DO





Bake for about 7 minutes. Rotate the pan and bake for another 8 minutes or until the chips are crisp, but not too brown. And that's it! See below how to make a delicious cheese sauce.













In a large micro-wave safe glass bowl, heat butter for 50 seconds on high or until the butter is melted.

Then whisk together the butter, flour and milk and add 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese.

Place bowl in microwave and cook on high for 11/2-2 minutes, whisking every 30 seconds or so, until sauce is thick and heated through.

Season with salt, if desired, whisk until blended.















Fold both top corners down toward you until the fold lines become visible, and crease.




and then flip the paper over.


WHAT TO DO



Fold the nose down toward you along the fold line, and crease.




Fold the plane in half, bring the wings together, and crease.




Fold the wings down along the fold line, and crease.




Finally, fold the winglets up along the fold lines.






Materials

- Cupcakes x 12
- White Fondant - 13.5 oz.
- Food Coloring: Red, Yellow, Blue, and Black



- Toothpick
- Plastic Knife






What To Do







Print sheet with the fondant color recipes and shape guide. Then make your cupcakes using your favorite recipe.







Follow the color guide and make vour different colored fondants.









Make your fondant pieces using the guide. Don't worry if they're not perfect. Can adjust as you go.









Lay down the base and layer the ear pieces. Fold and pinch the bottom of the ear. Place near top of cupcake.



What To Do _____





Add the head shape over the ears. Layer the eyes and put near the top, but leave room for the eyebrows.







Add eyebrows and cheeks. Layer the nose on top of cheeks. Use your toothpick to make Scooby's whisker holes on his cheeks.









Fold tongue piece in half and place below cheeks. Add the chin piece around the tongue.









Finally, wrap the collar around the bottom and add layered dog tag pieces.








Your Scooby cupcake is complete! Follow steps 3 - 8 to keep making more to share with your friends. Enjoy!





Instructions


- Shuffle numbered cards and place in a stack face down.




INSTRUCTIONS

- The winner of the game is the player who flips over the 'only' matching carrot cards.



First, paint the corks any color you like! Set aside while they dry.








Unroll the jewelry wire and cut it to desired length using the wire clippers.

Trace each target and it's stand onto cardboard. Cut all out.




Glue the target artwork onto each cardboard cutout.



Finally, attach the stands to the back of each target, using a piece of duct tape, as shown.


















I Ruv You! Picture Frame

WHAT TO DO









Print out the Scooby Frame template sheets and cut out each cardboard piece accordingly.







Grab your teal paint and apply it to one side of the cut out pieces, but paint both sides of the frame stand. Make sure the paint has dried, and then use your yellow paint to add the details to the tag, as shown.



WHAT TO DO







Flip the main frame piece over so the painted side is face down. Now score the cardboard along the templates dashed lines, using the pen.








Now you are ready to fold the frame along the scored lines, and glue them together! Don't glue the top, so you can put in an image.





Finally, slip in the provided artwork, or picture of your own, through the top of the frame, and fold the top flap closed. Now you are ready to show Mom how much you RUV her!










Print and cut out the Scooby face artwork. Glue onto the bag, as shown, and use your marker to make his whisker holes.









Then print and cut out your favorite character to add to your yogurt cup. Fold in half and then fold up the ends to glue to the top of the closed yogurt cup, as shown.






WHAT TO DO







Then use your hot glue gun to assemble the squares into a box. Add extra glue on the inside to close up any small gaps.





Next, it's time to paint. Pick any colors you like and do some simple color blocking. Don't worry about your lines being perfect, because once dry you will cover them with the foil tape.



Next, cut out your of character and glue
